Wow! Whole school attendance has increased to 96.1% this week. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child. There were 18 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality.

Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Gates open at 8.40am and learning starts at 8.45am. 5 children from 4 families were late this week which is a huge improvement. Please ensure your children do not miss out by being early. 10 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect contact from school and potentially a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team.

. If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning, enrichment experiences and time with their friends which all will have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.

#### **Extra-curricular Clubs**

Extra-curricular clubs for Y1-Y6 go live on Parent Booking on Friday 15th September at 7am. Places can only be reserved via booking online. Clubs begin the week commencing 18th September and run from 3-4pm.. They will run up to and including the final week of the half term. Forest School club costs £3 and payment must be made to secure your booking. If children are attending sports clubs or Forest School, they <u>must</u> bring trainers. They will not be able to join in wearing school shoes.

We will also be taking bookings for holiday camps via Parent Booking from now on. To secure your booking, select the dates wanted and make payment online. No bookings will be taken via the office anymore. Holiday camp costs £12.50 per day for all pupils.


#### **Forest School Sessions**
