Whole school attendance has dropped again to 92.8%. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child. There were 253 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality which needs to improve. Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Gates open at 8.40am and learning starts at 8.45am. 24 children from 20 families were late this week. Please ensure your children do not miss out by being early. 10 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect contact from school and potentially a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team. If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning, enrichment experiences and time with their friends which have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.

The 'It's Your Child's Life' programme is coming to Roby Park Primary School on **Monday 19th February** to help you help your child thrive at school. This 5-session course runs for an hour or so as soon as you've dropped your child off at the start of the day. We'll have the kettle on in school just before **8.50** am!

The course gives you a real insight into what your child will be learning at school and ways you can support learning at home. Each week you'll receive lots of practical tips and ideas as to how to help your child continue to develop skills in communication and language, personal development, physical development, reading, writing, maths, confidence and resilience.
