



Ready Steady Read Sponsored Event



To celebrate and encourage a lifelong love of reading at home and school, we are running a sponsored read between **4**th – **8**th **March**.

The project is being organised in conjunction with our local Usborne Partner, **Emma Evans** and all the money raised will go towards brand new books for our school. Whole school attendance has dipped slightly to 93.2%. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child. There were 605 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality which needs to improve. Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Gates open at 8.40am and learning starts at 8.45am. 27 children from 19 families were late this week. Please ensure your children do not miss out by being early. 10 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect contact from school and potentially a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team. If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning, enrichment experiences and time with their friends which have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.

Wellbeing at Roby Park

Over the next few weeks, we will share examples of how we continue to support wellbeing and mental health for all at Roby Park.

We use Zumos for children to confidentially share how they are feeling as they start the school day. Staff are then able to check in with children through the day to support them where needed. Podcasts are played through Zumos each day with different focus that teach the children 'How to be Happy'. We use the information



shared on Zumos to help target additional support for pupils as and when needed. This may include Yoga sessions, counselling, play therapy or time with a trusted member of staff to talk. Remember Zumos is also available to use at home and includes podcasts, calming techniques, games and more.

All that we do at Roby Park for mental health and wellbeing is to meet the needs of our children in the best way possible. This was recognised when we gained the Wellbeing Award for Schools award in Oct 2020. We look forward to our reassessment in March when we showcase all that we do.
