Whole school attendance dipped further below our target to 90.5%. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child. There were 523 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality which needs to improve. Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Gates open at 8.40am and learning starts at 8.45am. 18 children from 13 families were late this week. Please ensure your children do not miss out by being early. 10 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect contact from school and potentially a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team. If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning enrichment experiences and time with their friends which have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.

Letters have been sent via Class Charts with more details as well as added to the website.


No Mobile Phones on Site


Please ensure children have a packed lunch, water bottle and a coat each day.

Summer Uniform
