Do not tidy black structures away






What rules do we need to agree to when playing with....?

- When it is tidying up time, den building materials to be returned to designated den building area on the field.
- Constructa den pieces to be kept together.
- No destruction of others' den structures unless they are definitely finished with.
- Ask before going in someone else's den
- Taking down dens at the end of break
- Ask before you make any changes to a den that isn't yours.
- Consider allowing others into your den.
- Fold and put equipment away neatly in the correct place.
- Be mindful of personal space inside the den

Negotiate





- When 'HAPPY' plays, we all tidy away together. We have 4 minutes to clear up!
- Everybody is responsible for tidying away all equipment whether you played with it or not.
- Reading books back in the Reading Shed and doors closed.
- All large loose parts back to their designated area.
- Scooters and bikes back to the fence lines.
- Role play items returned to the shed.
- Sandpit to be emptied of resources.
- Basketballs and footballs put back in bags inside the shed.

Tidying Away







Items returned to their homes inside the large loose part store:

- Tuff trays and stands
- Small world trays with lids on
- Constructa den building trolley
- Sports equipment trolley balls, parachutes and space hoppers
- Sandpit resource trolley
- Den building fabrics, canes and pegs
- Hula hoops and skipping ropes
- Chalks
- Dance equipment
